ADMISSION GUIDELINES FOR THE SESSION 2018-2019

1. All admissions will be strictly on the basis of merit.
2. **For Hons. & General** online admission process will start on and from **11.06.2018** in the following manner:
 - a) Application form for Admission must be submitted through the website of our college and no printed forms will be available from anywhere. Whole admission process including fees payments should be done online. Initially the online application process will continue **up to 17th June 2018**.
 - b) Application fee Rs. **160.00** (Excluding Payment Gateway bank charges).
 - c) E-Receipt shall be obtained from the computer system after the submission of application fees (keep the e-receipt carefully for future correspondence).
 - d) The Provisional Merit List for all subjects will be published on the college website on **18.06.2018 at 7.00 PM**.
 - e) If any applicant's name is missing from the merit list, the candidate may contact the college authority within **18.06.2018(after 7 PM) to 19.06.2018 (between 4PM to 6 PM)** along with the e-receipt of his/her application.
 - f) The Final Merit List for all subjects will be published on the college website on **20.06.2018 at 7.00 PM**.
 - g) Admission will start from **22.06.2018** and will continue till further notice.
 - h) All admission related information will be available on the college website (www.msccollege.org).
 - i) **The admission of a candidate will be cancelled for any false / wrong declaration regarding their marks and other relevant data.**

a) Applicants for admission to 1st year classes must have passed H.S or equivalent examination.

b) Reservation of Seats: SC-22%, ST-6%, a few seats for OBC-A & OBC-B (Category wise No. of seats given below). Physically Handicapped -3% within each category and 18 Seats (**4 seats in B.Com Hons, 10 in B.Com General and 4 in B A General**) shall be reserved for outstanding Sports Personalities (participated at least in District level or Division Level)

c) Students applying for admission in **B.Com. Honours** course must pass with either Accountancy, Business Economics including Business Mathematics, Business Organization, Mathematics, Business Mathematics, Economics, Statistics, Business Studies, Office and Secretarial Practice, Financial Accounting, Elements of Cost Accountancy & Auditing, Book Keeping, Commerce, Cost Accountancy & Principle of Management.

d) Students applying for admission in **B.Com. General** course must pass with either Accountancy/ Business Economics including Business Mathematics/ Business Organization/ Mathematics/ Economics/ Statistics/ Commerce/ Accounts/ Business Studies/ Financial Accounting/ Office and Secretarial Practice/ Elements of Cost Accountancy and Auditing/ Book keeping/ Business Mathematics/ Cost Accountancy & Principle of Management.

e) The merit list will be prepared on the basis of the aggregate of best 4 subjects (**Marks in ENVS as Compulsory subject shall not be taken into account**).

10	B.A. (Gen.)	40% in Aggregate (i) If anyone choose Economics as a paper he/ she should have to secure pass marks in mathematics (ii) If anyone choose Geography he/she should secure 55% in Geography)
11	B.Sc. (Gen.)	Pass marks in HS or Equivalent Examination (i) If anyone choose mathematics as a paper he/ she should have to secure pass marks in mathematics. (ii) If anyone choose Economics as a paper he/ she should have to secure pass marks in mathematics. (iii) If anyone choose Geography he/she should secure 55% in Geography)
