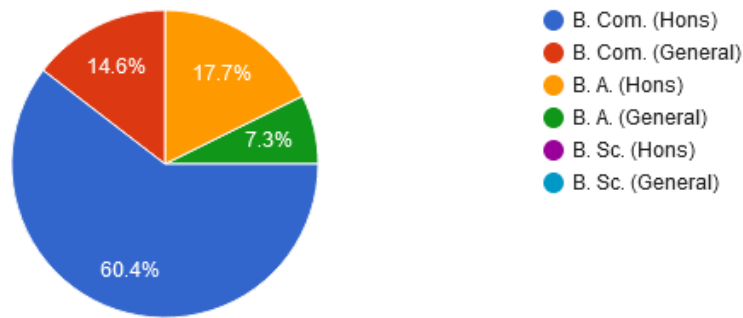


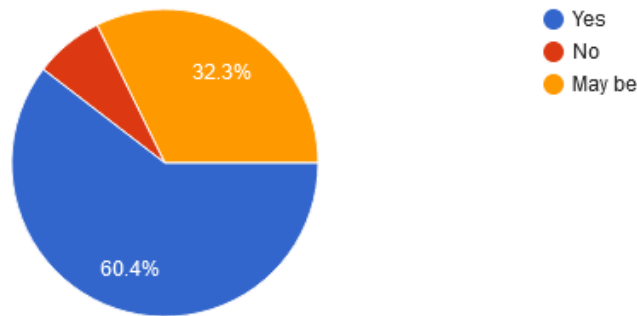
Report of Feedback of Alumnae concerning curriculum for the session 2023-24

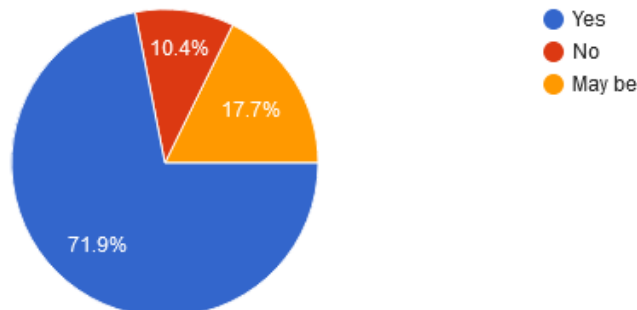
1. Programme Pursued



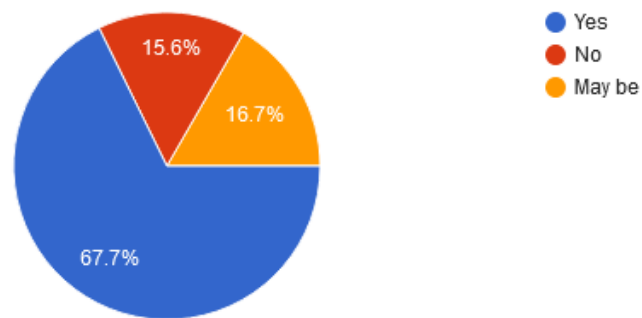
2. Did the curriculum help to develop effective communication skills, written and oral?



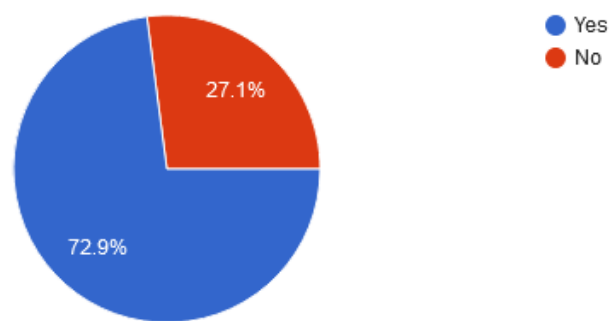
3. Did the curriculum teach students to be independent and critical thinkers capable of effective decision making?



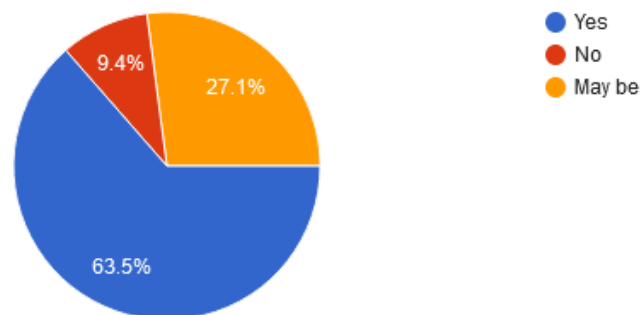
4. Was the college successful in instilling the value of time management and self-discipline through the curriculum?



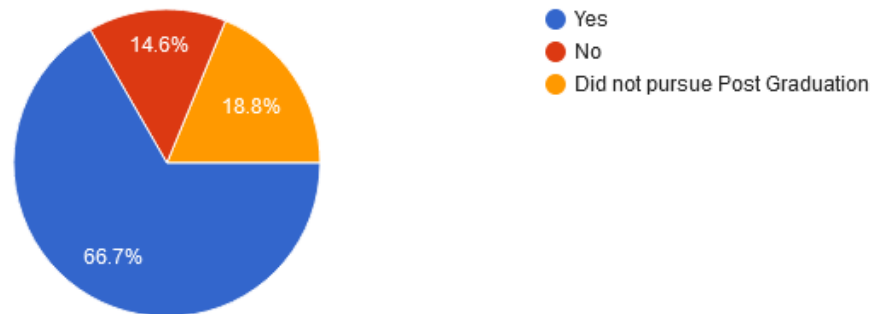
5. Did the college train students to deal with stress through effective curriculum delivery involving assessments at regular intervals?



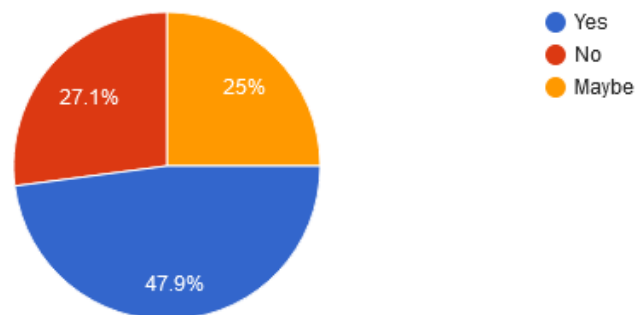
6. Has the teaching of value education and curriculum delivery helped students imbibe values of integrity, tolerance, inclusivity and gender sensitivity?
