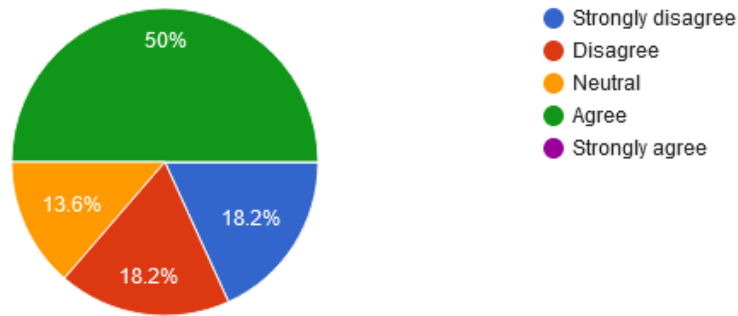


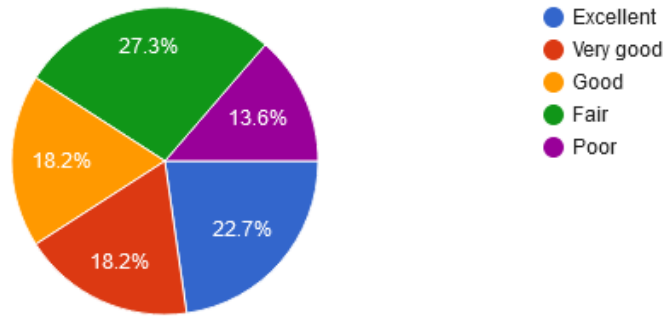
Report of Feedback of Alumnae concerning curriculum for the session 2023-24

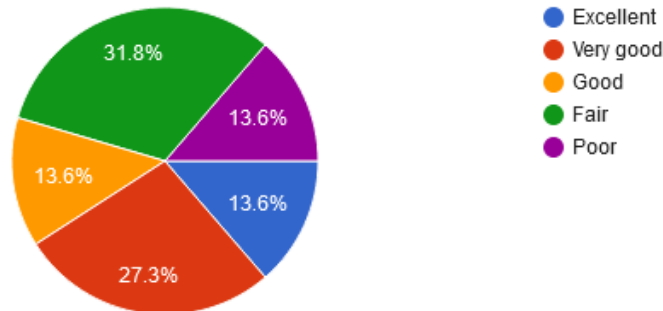
1. The curriculum has good balance between theory and applications



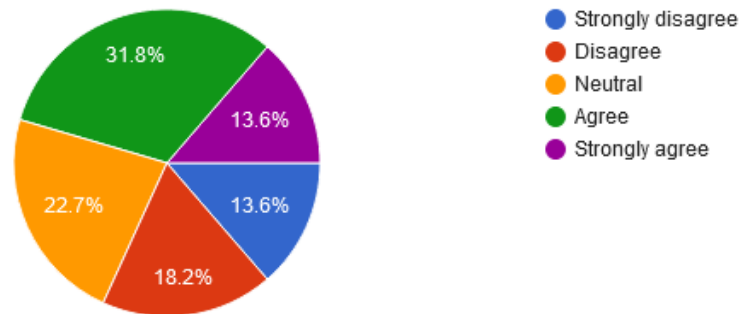
2. How do you rate the competencies/outcomes in relation to the course content?



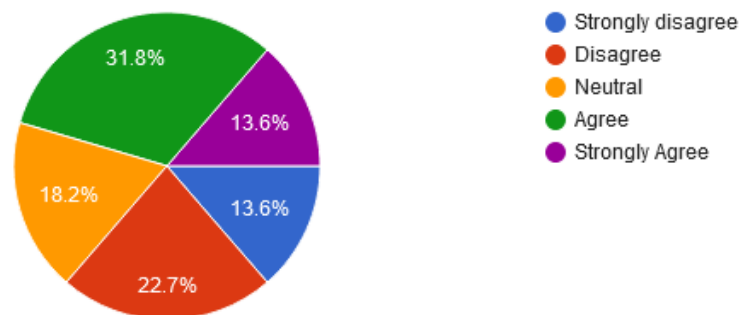
3. How do you rate the sufficiency of the courses related to industry that are included in the programme?



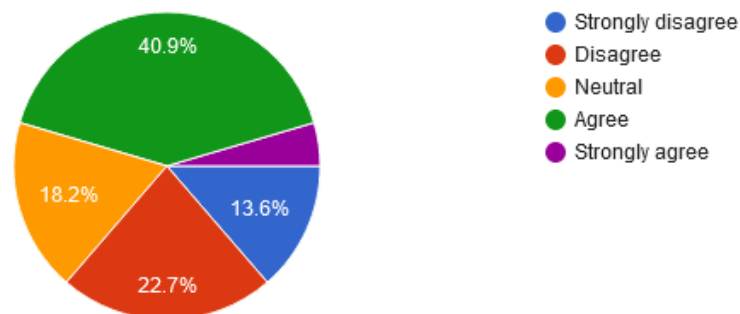
4. The curriculum incorporates soft skills needed for employment

7. Any Suggestion

- Current syllabus primarily stresses more on memorizing lot of information, none of which are needed in work place. No emphasis on real skill development.

- Curriculum should be more industry oriented and real life, than mere academic oriented
