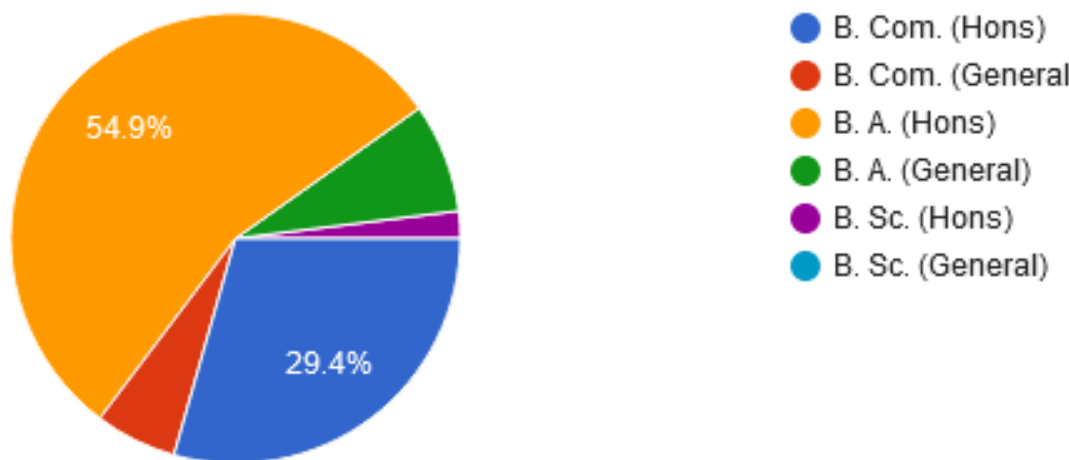


Report of Feedback of Parents concerning curriculum for the session 2023-24

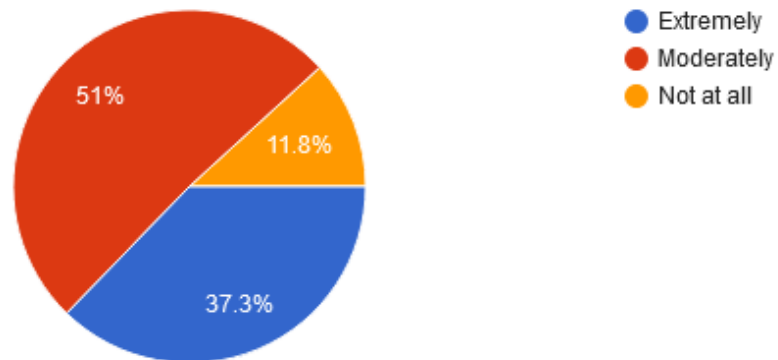

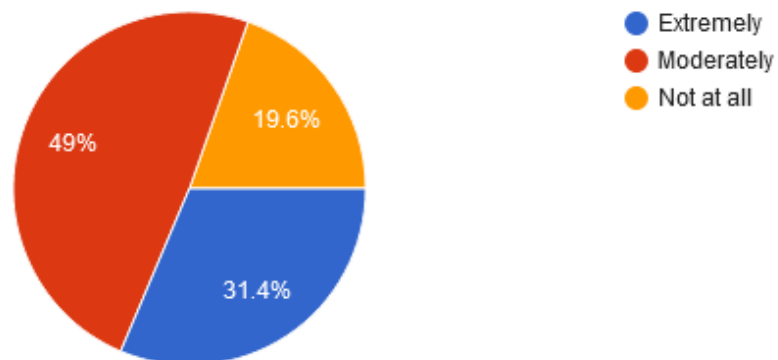

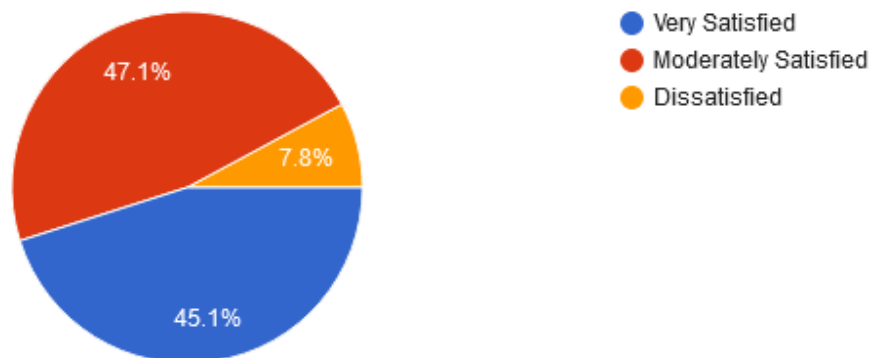
3. Are you satisfied with the curriculum design?



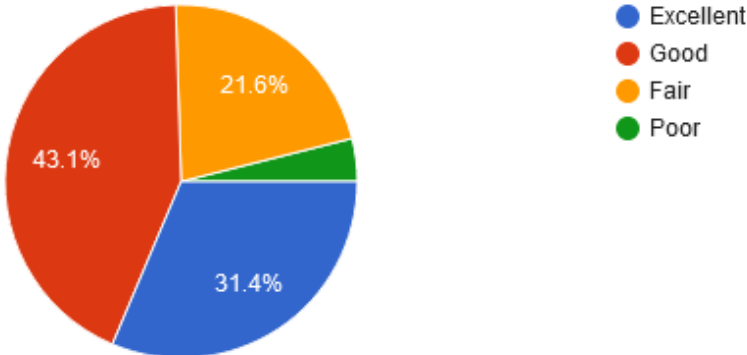
4. Is the study load very heavy?



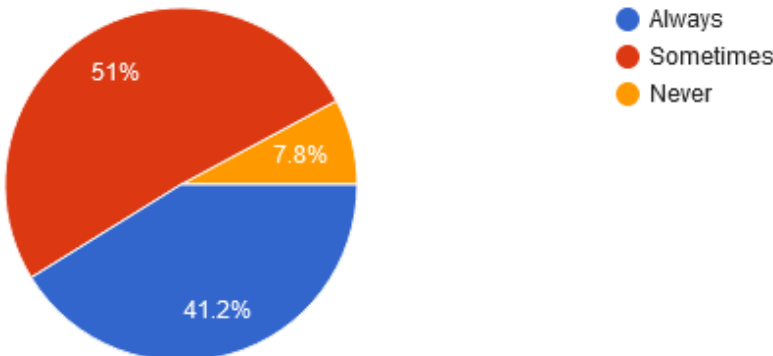
5. Are you satisfied with the manner in which your child is informed about the syllabus, course outcomes, time plans followed by faculty and the relevant reading lists?



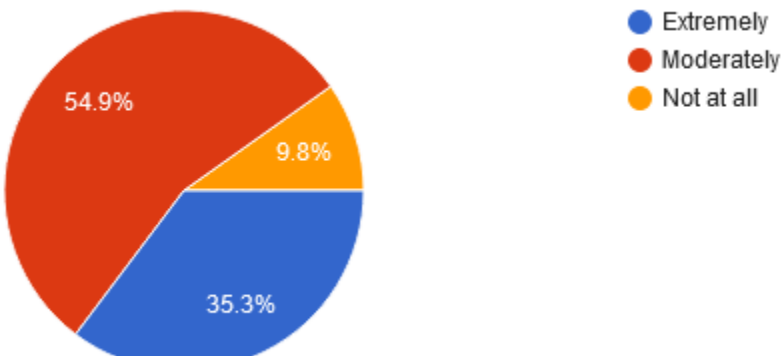
6. How would you rate the faculty's ability to deliver the curriculum effectively?



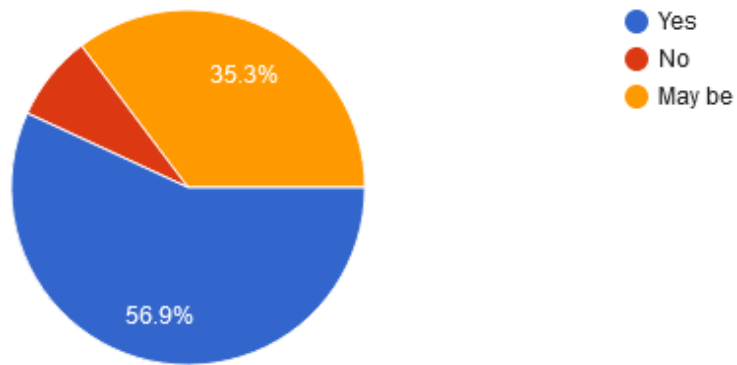
7. Does your child have easy access to relevant reference material?



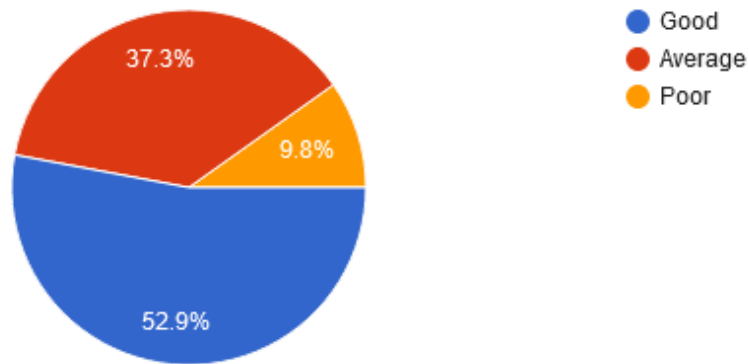
8. Is the curriculum relevant to child's future aspirations?



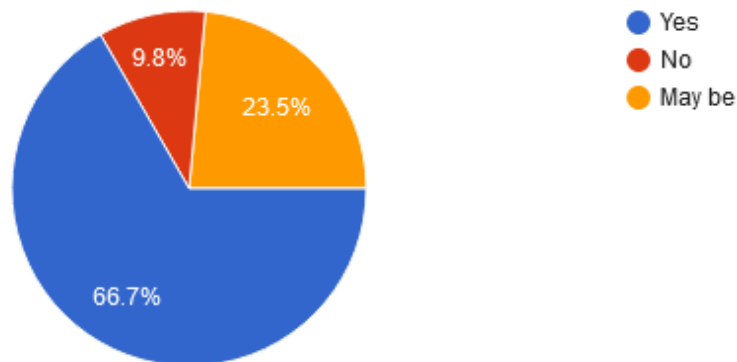
9. Does the curriculum impart the skills necessary for employability?



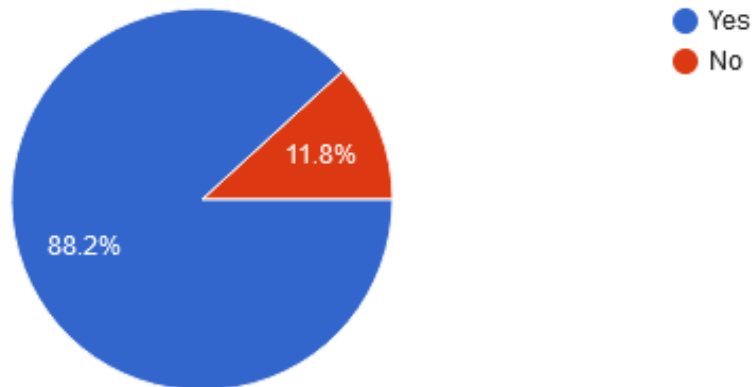
10. How effective is the faculty with regard to implementing the curriculum beyond classroom teaching through seminars, workshops, debates and field trips?



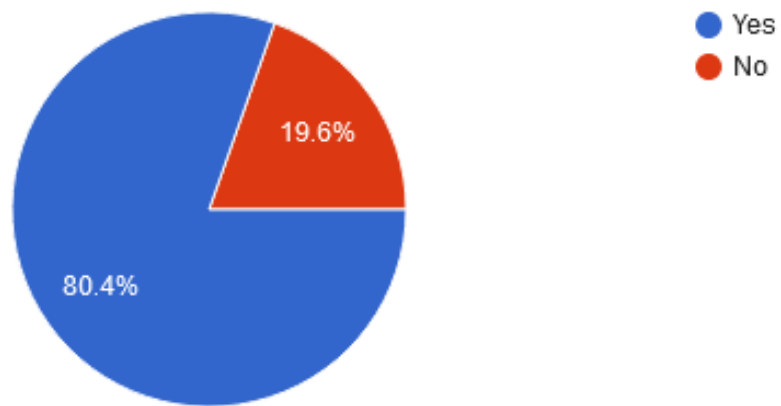
11. Does the college successfully train your ward in human values of compassion, discipline, integrity, inclusiveness and gender sensitivity through curriculum delivery?



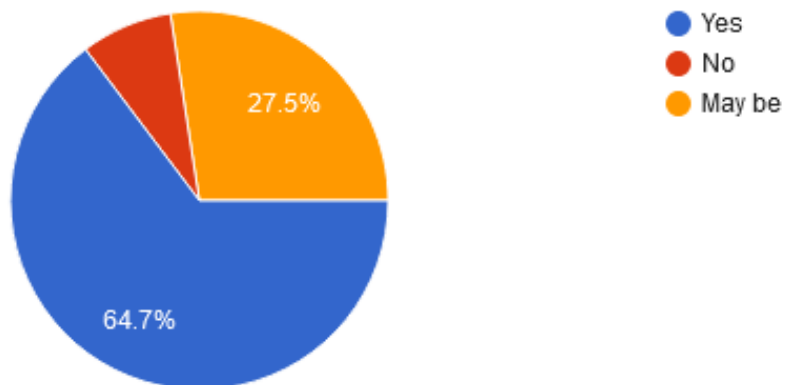
12. Are you satisfied with the Continuous Internal Assessment followed by the College?
